



**Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Nebraska**  
**Monthly Plan Premium for People who get Extra Help from Medicare**  
**to Help Pay for their Prescription Drug Costs**

If you get extra help from Medicare to help pay for your Medicare prescription drug plan costs, your monthly plan premium will be lower than what it would be if you did not get extra help from Medicare.

If you get extra help, your monthly plan premium will be \$0 for any of the plan(s) below. (This does not include any Medicare Part B premium you may have to pay.)

- Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Nebraska MA Core (HMO)
- Blue Shield of Nebraska MA Connect (PPO)

Blue Cross Blue Shield Nebraska MA Core, Blue Cross Blue Shield Nebraska MA Access, Blue Cross Blue Shield Nebraska MA Connect, and Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Nebraska Retiree Group MA PPO premiums include coverage for both medical services and prescription drug coverage.
